

Comedy - straight up dumb shit comedy




LOGLINE

San Francisco high security prison
(the one that replaced Alcatraz)



HOOK

"The only way to save their home, is to not escape"

SYNOPSIS

With prime land in the downtown San Francisco area at a premium, developers are climbing over themselves to secure the next site. One group owned by a greedy Chinese family look to snap up an old prison and turn the site into a boutique hotel – but there's a catch.

Inside the old dilapidated prison, all but five of inmates have been relocated. The five remaining inmates are all “special needs” inmates who have the same clause in their sentences that forbid the prison from relocating them – unless under provisions of the clause.

These long-term prisoners are not your average criminals. These inmates are the most emotionally fucked up individuals to walk the halls of this dingy old jail. All of the remaining inmates were sentenced to long term imprisonment by the same judge, who imposed the same restrictions, so the only way the last five inmates can be relocated, is if they escape and are recaptured, then resentenced.

The prison owner's two step-sons are the prison's ass-kissing chief warden and his “big” brother, the angry little dwarf of a unit guard. The owner deeply despises his two step-sons after his dying ex-wife's final wish was for him to take care of them.

In order to fulfill the owner's dreams, his two useless step-sons must concoct a plan for the inmates to escape, without the inmates knowing, however the inmates do get wind of this scheme and begin formulating their own counter-plan to protect their beloved home.

As the owner grows more impatient with his step-son's incompetence to remove the inmates, their tactics become so bold that it defies logic that these dysfunctional prisoners simply haven't walked out the front gate and right into freedom.

After weeks of harsh treatment by the guards and the worst meals imaginable, temptation grows stronger until an Indian inmate longing for his cousin's famous vindaloo in town succumbs to his cravings one night, and sneaks out of the prison for a long-awaited curry. In a panic, the other inmates head off on a desperate mission to bring their buddy back to prison before the guards realize that they have escaped.

What unfolds is a hilarious slapstick series of events that resembles a “Porky's” movie from the 1980's with “gastronomical consequences” through the streets of San Francisco as the other inmates desperately attempt to bring their lost Indian friend home.

PLOT GIVEAWAY

In the end the prisoners do make it home undetected but they discover that the owner's redevelopment plans were actually for a Boutique “prison experience” hotel where company's employees stay and partake in team building exercises, while our five dysfunctional inmates are employed by the hotel to bring authenticity to the experience.

THE CHARACTERS:



WAYNE "RAJA" KUER

(Late 30's) Indian national. Formally known as Yeseye Dicjamuma. Changed his name to Wayne Kuer, somehow thinking that was a better option.

Jailed for creating the world's largest Indian gourmet food pyramid scheme & franchising offshore call-centers to major corporations around the world.



PETER "THE SPONGE" JOHNSON

(50's) Samoan born twin brother of Dwayne Johnson. Former hell's angel bikie, turned king of the Tupperware industry after complaining that punching people made his soft hands hurt. Jailed for locking a man inside a life-sized Tupperware container to prove the seal was impregnable.



JAYD "JAYD-EN" HE/SHE




BERKLEY BINGLEY





CONCLUSION
